MGS UFE Calculation

We have received multiple queries from students regarding the University Free Elective (UFE) requirement mentioned.

<u>Please ignore the statement mentioned in the advisement report under UFE section which states "26</u> <u>units required"</u>

We would like to clarify the method to calculate University Free Electives is as follows (sample MGS report is attached **here**):

- 1. First check how many **Units** are left out of 130, as shown in this Academic advisement report (AAR) 23 are left in GREEN
- 2. After that, check how many units are pending from each bin i.e., University Core, MGS Business Core, MGS Major Core, MGS outgroup, MGS ingroup & MGS Major Elective and note them down. In this case 12 are left for the bins in BLUE.
- 3. Then, calculate the total units left out of 23 units after deducting the total from the other bins in BLUE. In this case, its 11
- 4. Therefore 11 UFEs are left
